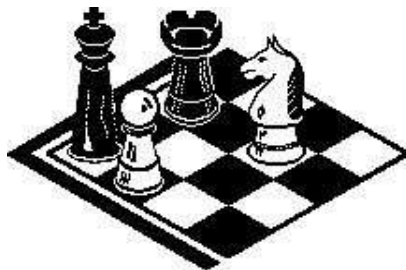


SS. Peter and Paul School and Chess Scholars present an Afterschool Chess Club *with Professional Instruction*
