What are the hours of the kindergarten classes?

Currently, the school day for all students begins at 7:45am (doors open at 7:30 am). The day ends at 2:05pm for kindergarten students (2:15pm for older students).

Where is the school entrance for kindergarten children?

Kindergarten students enter through the front doors on Ellsworth between 7:30am and 7:45am.

Will my kindergartener attend Mass during school hours?

Yes! Kindergarteners attend Mass with their classmates each week. The Mass schedule can be found on the website. Parents are more than welcome to join us for Mass.

What if I work full time and need after-school care?

You are not alone! For many Saints Peter and Paul parents, their greatest concern is where their child will stay after school. Parents at Saints Peter and Paul school have a unique alternative to solve that problem – the school’s Extended Day Program. Extended Day offers a safe and secure environment for children in grades K – 8. For the students, after school time in the Extended Day Program is fun and educational. Extended Day provides gym/play time, homework time, a snack and a variety of enrichment activities each afternoon. The uniqueness of the program lies in the fact that it is a self-supporting program. Cost for the program is \$17/day/child with a yearly registration fee of \$25 per family. Acceptance into the program is on a first-come, first-served basis while offering a choice of daily/weekly or monthly registration.

Do I pack lunches or is there a hot lunch program available?

There is a hot lunch program available every Monday. We offer a daily milk program. We also have pizza lunches one Friday a month. You can order these online at the school website www.sspeterandpaulschool.com.

How many children are in each kindergarten class?

There are approximately 22 children in each class. There is a classroom teacher and an aide.
