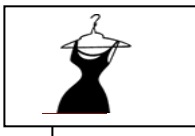

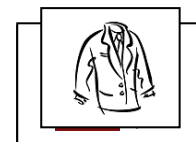

What is the Clothing Exchange & How do I buy or sell clothes for the sale?

Information on the Sale: In the Fall and the Spring, the Clothing Exchange is held at Ellsworth, Highland and Naper Elementary Schools in Naperville in which they transform their gyms into an infant/children/adult clothing resale shop. People from all over the area sign up to sell their gently used infant, children, or adult clothing. Buyers come on the designated sale dates to buy these clothes or infant items that the schools sell on behalf of those sellers. The school and the seller receive the profit from the sale of those items. Depending on the school the sellers can make 50 – 70% of the tagged price of the item when it sells and the school receives (depending on the school) 30- 50% of the sale price. The sellers tag the items with their seller number and the price they choose. The cards are provided by the schools along with directions on how to prepare your items for sale. The sellers choose whether they want to have the items reduced on Friday (white tag), not be reduced at all (salmon tag), or be reduced and donated if not sold (yellow tag).

Basic “How To” for Sellers:

1. Go to Seller Signup at the school that has the size of the clothes you need to sell.
2. Obtain your seller number, cards, and instructions at Seller Signup. Purchase any pins, hangers or shoe connectors (if Ellsworth or Highlands) you may need at the school.
3. **Follow the directions on the brochure you receive at Seller Signup as to what is acceptable and not for that school’s sale.**
4. Prepare your items by thoroughly cleaning them and preparing them to be tagged.
5. Use the cards provided by the school to tag your clothes and **follow the instructions on the brochure to fill in the cards.** Some schools charge if they are not done correctly.
6. Bring your clothes on the designated date and times for Receiving to the appropriate school. Don’t wait for the last day and/or time as this is always the busiest time. The first day and/or time are the best!
7. If you don’t want to wait in a line for dropping off your clothes make sure to use all yellow cards. This means you don’t want the clothes back if they don’t sell and they will sell for ½ prices on Friday. Even better if you drop off a self addressed envelope and give it to one of the chair people at the sale you don’t have to pick up your check on Saturday. It will be mailed to you!
8. To help you know what you sold and what you didn’t you can make a list of your items and number the cards on the back to keep track. If you pick up your items that weren’t sold on Saturday along with your check the envelope will have the cards in it showing you what was sold.
9. Keep your prices low! Remember if you were buying it would you pay the price on the card? Pricing is completely up to your judgment. We can only suggest if you want your item to sell to go with about 20% - 25% or less of what you bought it for unless it has tags still on it.

Basic for Buyers:

1. Be aware of areas you can and can not park on the streets by the school. In front of the school has a time restriction you need to be aware of and are posted.
2. Bring a basket with you to hold your items as you shop. Some schools will have this to help the shoppers but they quickly run out of them when it is busy.
3. There are only changing rooms at the Naper school. If you are going to the Ellsworth Sale and you have a daughter we recommend you have her dress in a leotard under her clothes so she can try on the items while at the sale.
4. Only checks and cash are accepted at the sales so be prepared. If you write a check bring your drivers license.
