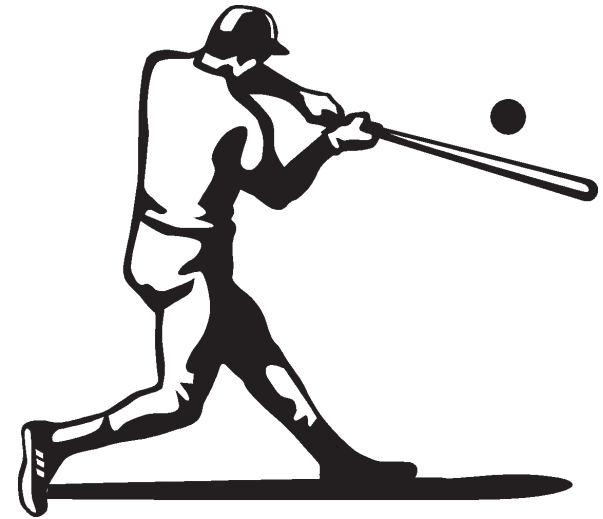

If your answers are "YES," you will be interested in attending the **Benedictine University Pre-Season Baseball Camp**. Baseball is a difficult game to master and the earlier you are exposed to the proper techniques and fundamentals, the more success and enjoyment can be realized.

Goals of the Camp...

The camp is designed for young men who want to become well schooled in the fundamentals of the game. The main goal of the camp is making certain each student receives individual instruction and coaching. Individual attention is assured by the camp's low instructor-to-camper ratio. **Players are grouped by age and ability.**

Experienced Staff...

John Ostrowski, Benedictine's head coach for 38 years, will head the staff. The rest of the staff will consist of Benedictine's assistant coaches and varsity players. Each camper's well-being is the full-time responsibility of the director and staff. This is the 17th year of the camp.

Camp Instruction...

Each week, the fundamentals are taught at a number of stations. In addition, each week has a special highlighted activity which makes learning fun and different. These activities include wiffle ball games, run, hit and throw competition, and videotaping of pitching and hitting.

Outstanding Facilities...

Instruction will take place at Benedictine's Dan and Ada Rice Center. The fieldhouse will have six hitting stations, three pitching stations and four defensive stations.
